Driving through parades. No driver of a vehicle shall drive between the vehicles or persons comprising a parade when such vehicles or persons are in motion and are conspicuously designated as a parade.

(c)

Parking on parade route. The Chief of Police shall have the authority, when reasonably necessary, to prohibit or restrict the parking of vehicles along a highway or part thereof constituting a part of the route of a parade. The Chief of Police shall post signs to such effect, and it shall be unlawful for any person to park or leave unattended any vehicle in violation thereof. No person shall be liable for parking on a street unposted in violation of this Section.

Revocation of permit. The Chief of Police shall have the authority to revoke a parade permit issued hereunder upon application of the standards for issuance as herein set forth.

(13)

Distribution of items. No person participating in the parade may sell, distribute or give away in any manner any pamphlet, article, good, ware, merchandise, candy or thing along the parade route while the parade is being conducted, unless:

(a)

The item to be distributed has been approved by the Chief of Police; and

(b)

The method of distribution involves one or more individuals walking along the curb line, distributing the item without the item being thrown or dropped into the street.
